Indian Institute of Information Technology, Allahabad (IIITA) at Prayagraj (U.P.) is an Institute of National Importance established in 1999 by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. The Institute offers B.Tech., M.Tech., M.B.A, Ph.D., and other programs of contemporary relevance to the aspiring learners, in the broad areas of Applied Sciences, Electronics and Communication Engg., Information Technology, Management Studies and their associated niche domains.

IIITA invites application for the posts of **Professor on regular positions**, from individuals having Doctoral degree from Institutions/Universities in India and from abroad, with conforming academic credentials, demonstrable high quality research, and committed leadership in innovative teaching-learning, under 4-Tier-Flexible Faculty Structure, addressing the needs of the disciplines/departments of Information Technology, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Applied Sciences, and Management Studies.

The number of vacancies, for this special drive, is 04 for the posts of Professor, addressing the needs of all the Departments in the Institute, taken together. Information on Reservations

- For the purpose of reservation of posts, as per the Gazette of India, No. 29, The CEI (Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) Act 2019, dated 9th July 2019, the Gazette of India, No. 2289, dated 12th July 2019, and further direction of Ministry of Education vide Notification F.No. 33-3/2018-TS.III dated 5th Nov 2019, the Institution has been treated as one unit.
- 2. The number of vacancies in all or any of the categories may be increased/decreased, without any notification.
- 3. The candidates belonging to categories viz. SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwD/EWS must attach the Caste/Category/Income certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format of the Government of India.
- 4. The Institute follows the Central list for SC/ST and OBC- NCLs.
- 5. NCL certificate for OBC candidates and Income cum Asset Certificate for EWS candidates should not be older than one year i.e. the candidate shall obtain and submit the relevant certificate, for the previous financial year (2022-23), which is issued on or after 01/04/2023.
- 6. The candidates belonging to reserved category are required to attach the Category certificate in the prescribed format of the Government of India, issued by the competent authority, not below the rank of a Tahsildar or from a first-class Magistrate of the place of domicile of the candidate clearly authenticating the category to which they belong to.
- 7. The reservations for differently-abled persons (PWD) are as per the Govt. of India. However, they shall be required to produce a medical certificate in the prescribed form issued by the competent medical authorities for the purpose of employment. Persons suffering from not less than 40% of the disability in a, b, d, and e category as per the Department of Personnel and Training Office Memorandum No. 36035/02/2017- Estt.(Res) dated 15th January 2018 shall only be eligible for the benefit of reservation and other relaxations, if any, as permissible under the rules.
- An EWS candidate shall be eligible for the benefit of reservation and other relaxations, if any, as permissible under the rules as per the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Office Memorandum F.No. 20013/03/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019 for reservation of Economically Weaker Sections.
- 9. The Institute encourages applications from qualified women candidates.

Note on Eligibility based on Qualifications and Experience:

- 1. The candidates may refer to the 'Govt. of India-MHRD's F. No. 27-11/2011 Ts.1 dated 23rd April 2014' on 'Implementation of 4-tier flexible faculty structure in the Indian Institutes of Information Technology', and the 'CEI Act-2019', for further information, in this regard.
- 2. In case, the candidate has passed and secured CGPA under any other point scale (other than 10-point scale), then the certificate issued by the authorized signatory (not the Mentor/Supervisor/Head of the Department) of the Institute/University to the effect of having secured first class in such degree must be attached. Alternately, the CGPA may be equivalently converted on 10-point scale for determination of eligibility.
- **3.** The above mentioned CGPA/Percentage/Degree should be awarded by a recognized University/Institute (having the authority to confer/award of such degree).
- 4. Candidates having PhD degree directly after B Tech will also be considered for the post, if they fulfill other criteria.
- 5. The candidates must have relevant teaching experience **in a regular grade** from the institutes of higher learning.
- 6. The date of birth mentioned in the Online Recruitment Application shall be treated as final. The candidates must attach the relevant document as proof of age with the application.

7. All qualifications, experiences and other criteria will be considered as on or before the closing date of online application forms.

- 3. The Institute reserves the right to prioritize the required research/academic expertise based on the Institute's needs.
- 4. For the Department of Management Studies, the publications in the ABDC-listed journals are equivalent to those in the SCI journals.

Selection Procedure

1. After Screening/short-listing of applications and profiles of the candidates, by the duly constituted Screening Committee for the purpose, based on the Institute decided criteria, the shortlisted candidates shall be invited for an 'in-person' presentation followed by interview, before the Statutory Selection Committee. Based on the recommendations of this Statutory Selection Committee and approval of the Board of Governors of the Institute, appointment letters shall be issued.

- 'Essential Educational qualifications & experience, other essential requirements and additional desirable requirements' mentioned in the Table-II above, are the minimum eligibility criteria for academic & research credentials. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate for being called for any part of selection process.
- 3. The Institute reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to a reasonable limit for interviews before the Statutory Selection Committee, on the basis of qualifications, eligibility and experience, other academic & research achievements higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement.
- 4. The Institute may adopt some other criterion and/or procedural step to restrict the number of candidates to be invited for interviews before the Statutory Selection Committee.
- 5. The Institute also reserves the right to decide areas of specialization while short listing, taking into account the specific requirements of the individual departments. The short listing norms may not be uniform across all the departments of the Institute and shall be binding on the applicants. The decision of the Institute related to all matters pertaining to the recruitment shall be final and binding on the applicants.
- 6. The decision of the respective committees shall be final, in this regard.
- 7. Apart from merit, the specialization of a candidate aligned for a particular department will play a vital role in selection. The candidate with a specialization in greater need by the department may be given preference.
- 8. The Institute reserves the right to relax any of the qualifications/experience criteria in case of exceptionally outstanding candidates.

Other Instructions

- 1. The Institute reserves the right to fill/partially fill or not to fill any vacancies or cancel the selection process wholly or partially at any stage based on the availability of vacancies in any or all of the categories, which may be increased or decreased, at the time of presentation/interview, without any notification.
- 2. The candidates who had applied earlier need to apply afresh. Old applications will not be considered.
- 3. As an Institute of National Importance, IIIT, Allahabad strives to have a workforce which reflects an all-India character and hence candidates from all over the country are encouraged to apply. Only Indian Nationals, Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) and overseas citizens of India (OCI) are eligible to apply. The persons holding the foreign passport are required to provide the details in the application form. Offer of appointment for the individuals with foreign passports will be issued only after the Political and security clearance from Ministries of External Affairs and Home Affairs is obtained.
- 4. IIIT-Allahabad adheres to the 'No In-breeding' policy. Therefore, a candidate who has obtained or is expected to obtain his/her most recent degree (Ph.D) from IIIT-Allahabad will normally not be considered for recruitment, except where there is a 3 years gap between leaving the Institute and the last date of application.
- 5. Higher initial basic pay may be recommended to the deserving candidate(s) with relevant experience by the selection committee.
- 6. Any Addendum/ Corrigendum/ Clarification will be published only on the Institute website (<u>www.iiita.ac.in</u>). Any update on shortlisted candidates, recruitment schedule etc. will be notified on the Institute website only. Hence, the candidates are requested to keep a copy of their application with

them for their reference and advised to periodically visit the Institute website for information/ updates. The date and time of Presentation/ Interview will be informed only through the Institute website / e-mail. The Institute will not be responsible for non-receipt of emails by the candidates.

- 7. To and fro fare up-to railway-AC 3 tier by the shortest route (only for travel within India) will be paid by the institute on submission of tickets. Tatkal charges and local travel charges shall not be reimbursed. Accommodation will be provided in institute's visitors' hostel at institute subsidized rate.
- 8. Applicants should not have been convicted by any court of law.
- 9. Candidates may be posted and/or transferred to another department at any time during service career, in the interest of the Institute.
- 10. Candidates are advised to fill the information carefully in the online application form. Institute will neither be responsible for any wrong information furnished nor accept any subsequent requests for making any corrections by the candidate(s). The candidate(s) shall be solely responsible for the information filled in the online application form. No change/deviation, whatsoever, will be entertained.
- 11. The candidates may be disqualified at anytime during the process and may even be liable for disqualification after the appointment, if it is found that they have furnished incorrect and false information, intentionally or otherwise.
