Indian Institute of Information Technology, Allahabad (IIITA) at Prayagraj (U.P.) is an Institute of National Importance established in 2000 by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. The Institute offers B.Tech., M.Tech., M.B.A, Ph.D., and other programs of contemporary relevance to the aspiring learners, in the broad areas of Applied Sciences, Electronics and Communication Engg., Information Technology, Management Studies and their associated niche domains.

IIITA invites application for the vacant posts of **Professor and Associate Professor on regular positions**, from individuals having Doctoral degree from reputed Institutions/Universities from India and abroad, with an excellent scholastic record in academics, demonstrable high quality research, and committed leadership in innovative teaching-learning, under 4-Tier-Flexible faculty Structure in the disciplines of Information Technology, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Applied Sciences, and Management Studies. **The number of vacancies, presently, is 04 and 12 respectively for the posts of Professor and Associate Professor**, addressing the needs of all the departments and is subject to change.

Reservation is applicable as per Government of India rules. The candidate belonging to reserved categories (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwD/EWS) are required to attach the Caste/Category/Income certificate issued by the competent authority in prescribed format of Government of India. The Institute follows the Central list in the case of SC/ST and OBC-NCLs. OBC-NCL certificate should not be older than one year. The institute also encourages applications from qualified women candidates.

Notes on Eligibility based on Qualifications and Experience:

1. In case, the candidate has passed and secured CGPA/CPI, under any other pointer scale than 10, the certificate issued by the authorized signatory from the respective University/Institute, to the effect of having secured First class, shall be attached, or else, the CGPA/CPI may be equivalently converted on a 10-point scale to determine eligibility.
2. The candidates must have relevant teaching experience in regular grade from the institutes of repute e.g. IISc/IITs/IIITs/NITs/IISERs/IIMs/ISI.

Selection Procedure

1. After Screening/short-listing of applications and profiles of the candidates, by the duly constituted Screening Committee for the purpose, based on the Institute decided criteria, the shortlisted candidates shall be invited for an 'in-person' presentation followed by interview, before the Statutory Selection Committee. Based on the recommendations of this Statutory Selection Committee and approval of the Board of Governors of the Institute, appointment letters shall be issued.
2. Essential Educational qualifications, experience and other essential requirements are the minimum eligibility criteria. The Institute reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates for interviews before the Statutory Selection Committee, to a reasonable limit, on the basis of qualifications, eligibility and experience, higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement, and other academic achievements. The Institute may adopt some other criterion and/or procedural step to restrict the number of candidates to be invited for interviews before the Statutory Selection Committee, for which the candidates will be intimated in advance.
3. The decision of the respective committees shall be final, in this regard.
4. To and fro fare up-to railway-AC 3 tier by the shortest route (only for travel within India) will be paid by the institute on submission of tickets. Tatkal charges and local travel charges shall not be reimbursed. Accommodation will be provided in institute's visitors' hostel at institute subsidized rate.

Other Instructions

1. The Candidates who had applied earlier need to apply afresh. Old application will not be considered.
2. Only Indian Nationals, Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) and overseas citizens of India (OCI) are eligible to apply. The persons holding the foreign passport are required to provide the details in the application form. Offer of appointment for the individuals with foreign passports will be issued only after the Political and security clearance from Ministries of External Affairs and Home Affairs is obtained.
3. IIIT-Allahabad adheres to the 'No In-breeding' policy. Therefore, a candidate who has obtained or is expected to obtain his/her most recent degree (Ph.D) from IIIT-Allahabad will normally not be considered for recruitment, except where there is a 3 years gap between leaving the Institute and the last date of application.
4. Higher initial basic pay may be recommended to the deserving candidate(s) with relevant experience by the selection committee.
5. Any Addendum/ Corrigendum/ Clarification will be published only on the Institute website (www.iiita.ac.in). Any update on shortlisted candidates, recruitment schedule etc. will be notified on the Institute website only. Hence, the candidates are requested to keep a copy of their application with them for their reference and advised to periodically visit the Institute website for information/ updates.

The date and time of Presentation/ Interview will be informed only through the Institute website / e-mail. The Institute will not be responsible for non-receipt of emails by the candidates.

6. Applicants should not have been convicted by any court of law.
7. Candidates may be posted and/or transferred to another department at any time during service career, in the interest of the Institute.
8. Candidates are advised to fill the information carefully in the online application form. Institute will neither be responsible for any wrong information furnished nor accept any subsequent requests for making any corrections by the candidate(s). The candidate(s) shall be solely responsible for the information filled in the online application form. No change/deviation, whatsoever, will be entertained.
9. The candidates may be disqualified at anytime during the process and may even be liable for disqualification after the appointment, if it is found that they have furnished incorrect and false information, intentionally or otherwise.

11. Incomplete/ partially filled application forms will not be considered. The decision of the Institute authorities in such cases will be final.
12. The applicants are required to upload all the supporting documents mandatory to complete the applications.
13. Separate sheet, if required, may be attached along with application.
14. The Institute reserves the right to fill/partially fill or not to fill any vacancies or cancel the selection process wholly or partially based on the availability of vacancies in particular category at the time of presentation/interview.
15. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
16. Applications sent through email/FAX will not be considered.

17. A candidate applying for a post can be called for interview for lower post also, if Committee recommends so.
18. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate for being called for any part of selection process. The Institute reserves the right to relax any of the qualifications/experience in exceptional cases.

Persons suffering from not less than 40% of the disability in a, b, d, and e category as per the Department of Personnel and Training Office Memorandum No. 36035/02/2017- Estt(Res) dated 15th January 2018 shall only be eligible for the benefit of reservation and other relaxations, if any, as permissible under the rules.
24. An EWS candidate shall be eligible for the benefit of reservation and other relaxations, if any, as permissible under the rules as per the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Office Memorandum F.No. 20013/03/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019 for reservation of Economically Weaker Sections.
25. Candidates must ensure before applying that they are eligible according to the criteria stipulated in the advertisement. If the candidate is found ineligible at any stage of recruitment process, he/she will be disqualified and their candidature will be cancelled.
