NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT) FOR PROVIDING MANPOWER SERVICE AT IIIT-A ON OUTSOURCING BASIS

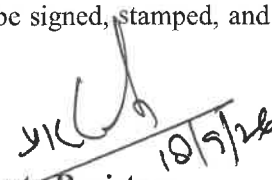

With reference to the Tender No. IIIT-A/SP/NIT/1987/2879/2026 dated 25.08.2026 for "Providing Manpower Service at IIIT-A on outsourcing basis", the following clarifications/corrections are hereby communicated for information and compliance by all prospective bidders:

S. No.	Tender Clause	Amendment
1	Clause 4.58.11 – Statutory Liabilities & Statutory Bonus	Bonus shall not be applicable under this Tender.
2	Clause 4.12 – Uniforms	The cost of dress code/uniforms required for the deployed manpower shall be borne entirely by the Service Provider. Such cost shall be deemed to be included in the Service Charges quoted by the bidder and shall not be separately reimbursed by the Institute.
3	Clause 4.13 – Mandatory PPE Gear	The Service Provider shall provide the required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including helmets, safety harnesses, gumboots, safety shoes, gloves, masks, jackets, etc., as applicable to the nature of work being performed by the deployed manpower. The Service Provider must obtain prior written approval from the Institute regarding the specifications, quantities and estimated costs of the PPE items before procurement. Reimbursement for the Institute-approved PPE gear shall be made on an actual invoice basis, subject to a maximum financial ceiling of Rs. 1,500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred only) per deployed worker per annum, or the actual expenditure incurred, whichever is lower. No reimbursement shall be admissible without prior written approval of the Institute.

4	Clause 4.16 – Life Insurance for Non-ESI Personnel	The successful bidder shall arrange and maintain a valid employees' contributory Group Life Insurance Policy for all deployed personnel who are not covered under the Employees' State Insurance (ESI) Scheme, in the manner prescribed/approved by the Institute at the time of award of the contract. The policy shall remain valid throughout the period of deployment and shall provide coverage against death and other applicable risks as per the policy terms. Documentary proof of such insurance coverage shall be submitted to the Institute before deployment and whenever required during the currency of the contract. The Institute shall not be responsible for any liability arising due to failure of the Service Provider to obtain or maintain the required insurance coverage. The Service Provider must obtain prior written approval from the Institute regarding the proposed policy coverage, list of personnel to be covered and premium quotation before procurement/renewal of the insurance policy. Reimbursement of the insurance premium, if admissible, shall be made on actuals, subject to mutual consent/approval of the Institute.
5	Financial BOQ & CPPP – Service Charge	The Service Charge quoted in the CPPP Financial BOQ, within the prescribed range of 3.85% to 7.00%, shall strictly cover the administrative, managerial and overhead costs of providing the manpower services.
6	Financial BOQ – PPE & Insurance	Bidders shall NOT quote/upload any separate price bid, rate quotation or PDF containing rates for PPE, insurance or any other reimbursable component on CPPP. The financial bid shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the prescribed CPPP Financial BOQ. Any bidder uploading a separate price/rate attachment for PPE, insurance or such components may be liable for rejection of the bid.

Important Note: All other terms, conditions, specifications, and scope of work as published in the original Tender Enquiry Document (Ref No.: IIIT-A/SP/NIT/1987/2879/2026) shall remain unchanged and fully applicable. This Corrigendum forms an integral part of the Tender Document and must be signed, stamped, and uploaded along with the Technical Bid submission.
